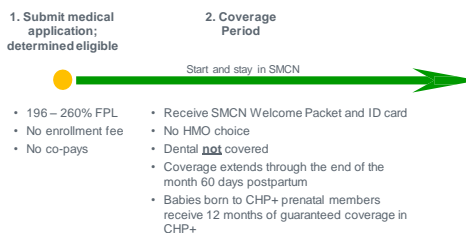

- All HMOs must provide base level of medical services covered by the SMCN



Summary of CHP+ Benefits

- Preventive care
- Physician visits
- Prescription drugs
- Durable medical equipment
- Inpatient and outpatient hospital services
- Maternity care (prenatal, delivery and postpartum)
- Reproductive health services
- Vision services
- Audiology services
- Lab and imaging services
- Outpatient surgery
- Emergency room and urgent care services
- Emergency transportation
 - Does not cover non-emergency medical transportation
- PT/OT/Speech
- Home health care
- Skilled nursing facility
- Behavioral health services
- Substance use disorder services
- Transplant services (limited)
- Dental care (for kids only)

Co-Payments

- Co-payments
 - Based on income and services rendered
 - No co-pays for prenatal women
- Annual out-of-pocket limit
 - 5% of adjusted gross income

Examples of Co-Payments for Different Services Rendered

Future of CHP+

CHIP Landscape

- ACA reauthorized CHIP through FY 2019, but did not reauthorize funding past FY 2015
 - Authorized a 23 percentage point FMAP bump
 - Maintenance of effort (MOE)

- H.R. 2 Medicare Access & CHIP Reauthorization Act
 - 2-year extension through September 2017
 - 23 percentage point bump
- National workgroups



Future of CHP+ Goal

By September 2017, all children and pregnant women currently covered by CHP+ will have access to comparable sources of physical and behavioral health and dental coverage with respect to affordability, adequacy of benefits and availability of services.
